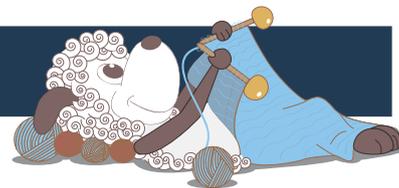


Siri - a lovely pair of baby pants with sweet details

A lovely pair of baby pants with sweet details at the ankles and around the waist.

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English translation: Signe Strømgaard

Materials

100 (100) 150 (150) g of Anina by Filcolana in color 356 (Woodland Dawn)
3 circular needle, 40 cm long
3 mm double-pointed needles
2 stitch holders.

Sizes

3 (6-9) 12-18 (24) months

Measurements

Leg length (at inseam): Approx. 20 (23) (27) 31 cm

Gauge

28 sts and 40 rows in stockinette stitch. There are now 10 x 10 cm

Directions for knitting

The pants are worked from the top down.

Special abbreviation

M1 (increase): Make 1. Increase one stitch by lifting the chain between sts onto the left needle and knitting it through the back loop.

Sk2p (decrease): slip 1 stitch knit-wise, k2, pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitches.

Sl: Slip stitch(es) purl-wise with the yarn i held back.

Turning stitch (short rows): Pull the yarn up and over the right needle, slip the first stitch on the left needle as if to purl. Pull the working yarn away from yourself, so the stitch (now on the right needle) is pulled backward, creating a "double stitch". Keep the tension



in the yarn while working the next stitch.
When working the "double stitch" on the next row of round, work the stitch as one stitch.

Pants

Cast 105 (120) 130 (135) sts on a 3 mm circular needle.

Join in the round being careful not to twist and place a marker for the beginning of the round.

Round 1 (RS): *k3, p2*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 2: *sk2p, p2*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 3: *k1, yarn over, k1, p2*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 4: *k3, p2*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Repeat these 4 rounds until the work measures 8 (8) 10 (12) cm. End on Row 2. There are now 84 (96) 104 (108) sts on the needle.

Increase round: *k1, yarn over, k1, yarn over, k1, yarn over, k1*. Repeat from * to * to end of round, yarn over after the last stitch of the round (between the last stitch and the beginning of round marker). There are now 148 (169) 183 (190) sts on the needle.

Next round: *[k1, knit the yarn through the back loop] 3 times, k1*. Repeat from * to * end of round. End by knitting the final yarn over through the back loop.

Size 6-9 months only: K2tog, knit to end of round. There are now 168 sts on the needle.

Size 12-18 months only: M1, knit to end of round. There are now 184 sts on the needle.

Size 24 months only: M1, k95, M1, knit to end of round. There are now 192 sts on the needle.

All sizes

To create a better fit, short rows are worked (back and forth on the circular needle):

Knit 111 (126) 138 (144) sts, place a marker (=mid back), k5, turn.

Next row (WS): 1 turning stitch, 4 vr, slip marker, p5, turn.

Next row: 1 turning stitch, 4 r, slip marker, k15, turn.

Next row: 1 turning stitch, 14 vr, slip marker, p15, turn.

Next row: 1 turning stitch, 14 r, slip marker, k25, turn.

Next row: 1 turning stitch, 24 vr, slip marker, p25, turn.

Next row: 1 turning stitch, 24 r, slip marker, k35, turn.

Next row: 1 turning stitch, 34 vr, fjern markøren p35, turn.

Next round (RS): 1 turning stitch, knit to end of round.

Work straight in stockinette stitch until the work mea-

sures 18 (20) 25 (26) cm, measured mid front.

Wedge

Knit 36 (41) 45 (47) sts, place marker, k1 (= center front stitch), place marker, knit 73 (83) 91 (95) sts, place marker, k1 (= center back stitch), place marker, knit 37 (42) 46 (48) sts.

Round 1: Knit to first marker, slip marker, M1, k1 (mid front), M1, slip marker, knit to next marker, slip marker, M1, k1 (mid back), M1, slip marker, knit to end of round. 4 sts have been increased.

Work an increase round as above every 2nd (2nd) 3rd (3rd) round another 5 times (note that there are 2 sts more between each stitch marker for each increase round) until there are 13 sts between markers.

Knit 1 round.

Next round: Knit to first marker, remove marker and k13, place the last 13 sts on a stitch holder (bottom of wedge), remove marker, knit to next marker, 13, place the last 13 sts on a stitch holder, remove marker, knit to end of round. There are now 146 (166) 182 (190) sts on the needle.

Finish each leg separately.

Leg

Move the sts for the first leg onto 4 double-pointed needle. There are now 73 (83) 91 (95) sts on the needle.

Join in the round and work in stockinette stitch until the leg measures 14 (17) 21 (24) cm from where the sts were split.

Decrease on the next round:

Size 0-3 months only: k2tog, [k1, k2tog] 12 times, k2tog, [k1, k2tog] 11 times. There are now 48 sts on the needle.

Size 6-9 months only: k2tog, [k1, k2tog] 7 times, [k2tog] 3 times, [k1, k2tog] 18 times. There are now 54 sts on the needle.

Size 12-18 months only: [k1, k2tog, k2tog, k2tog] 3 times, [k1, k2tog, k2tog] 14 times. There are now 54 sts on the needle.

Size 24 months only: [k2tog, k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog] 5 times, [k2tog, k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog] 5 times. There are now 60 sts on the needle.

Edge (mock cables on both RS and WS):

Round 1: *sk2p, p3*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 2: *k1, yarn over, k1, p3*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 3: *k3, sp2p*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 4: *k3, p1, yarn over, p1*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Repeat these 4 rounds until the edge measures 8 cm. End on Round 1 (if you do not want a folded cuff, only knit for 5 cm).

Bind off in pattern on the next round.

Work the second leg the same way as the first.

Finishing

Knit the wedge sts together using a 3-needle bind-off:

Place the two sets of stitches parallel to each other, RS to RS. Knit the first stitch on the front left needle together with the first stitch on the back left needle, *knit the next stitch on the front left needle together with the next stitch on the back left needle, pass the first stitch on the right needle over the second, binding it off*. Repeat from * to * until all sts are bound off.

Sew the little holes at the side of the wedge. Weave in the ends.

Tie (not necessary for the smallest sizes, but useful for babies who can walk):

Cast on 3 sts on a double-pointed needle, *without turning the needle, push the sts to the opposite end of the needle, pull the yarn along the back of the work and knit the 3 sts*. Repeat from * to * until the tie measures approx. 70 cm. knit the 3 sts together. Weave in the ends. Pull the tie through the holes in the cables approx. 4 cm from the cast-on edge.

Gently wash the finished pants and lay it flat on a towel to dry.
