

Lace pattern

(see chart below)

Row 1 (RS): Sl1, k6, *k1, k2tog, yarn over, k1, yarn over, skp, k1*. Repeat from * to * to the last 7sts, k6, p1.

Row 2: Sl1, k6, strik vr til de sidste 7sts, k6, p1.

Row 3: Sl1, k6, *k2tog, yarn over, 3 r, yarn over, skp*. Repeat from * to * to the last 7sts, k6, p1.

Row 4: Work as Row 2.

Repeat Row 1- 4 until the blanket measures approx. 76 cm. End on a Row 4.

Edge

Next row (RS): Sl1, knit to the last stitch, p1.

Repeat Row 1 a total of 13 times (= 7 garter ridges), ending on a WS row.

Sew bind-off (see photo tutorial at the end of the pattern)

To create a cast-off the is the mirror image the cast-off, cast-off with a sewn cast-off: Break the yarn so you have a tail approx. 3 times the width of the blanket. *Hold the blanket with the RS facing you. Insert the needle through the first stitch on the left needle as if to purl, and pull the yarn through the stitch, but leave the stitch on the needle.

Hold the yarn to the front and insert the needle through the third stitch on the left needle as if to knit, so the needle comes out at the back of the work. Pull the yarn through, then let the first stitch fall off the needle*. Repeat from * to * until all the stitches have been sewn and bound off.



*Hold the blanket with the RS facing you. Insert the needle through the first stitch on the left needle as if to purl.



Hold the yarn to the front of the work and insert the needle through the third stitch on the left needle as if to knit, so the needle comes out at the back of the work.



Let the first stitch fall off the needle*. Repeat from * to * until all the stitches have been bound off.
